To embed a lecture, including an interview or case study in your application of choice (PowerPoint, Word, Moodle, Blackboard, etc.) click on the 'Embed in Course/Own Notes' button when playing the video.

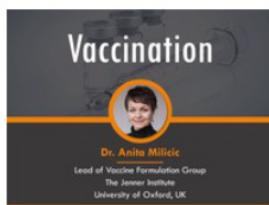

EMBED AS LINK

Use this option to create a thumbnail that serves as a link to the video on the HSTalks website.

There are two ways to embed a lecture as a link:

A. Drag and Drop: – 'dragging and dropping' the thumbnail from the 'preview' is the simpler way.

1. Hover with the mouse over the thumbnail.
2. Press and hold down the left button of the mouse.
3. Move the mouse cursor to the location where you wish to 'drop' the lecture (e.g. in PowerPoint, Email, Word, Moodle or other VLE etc.).
4. Release the button to embed the lecture.

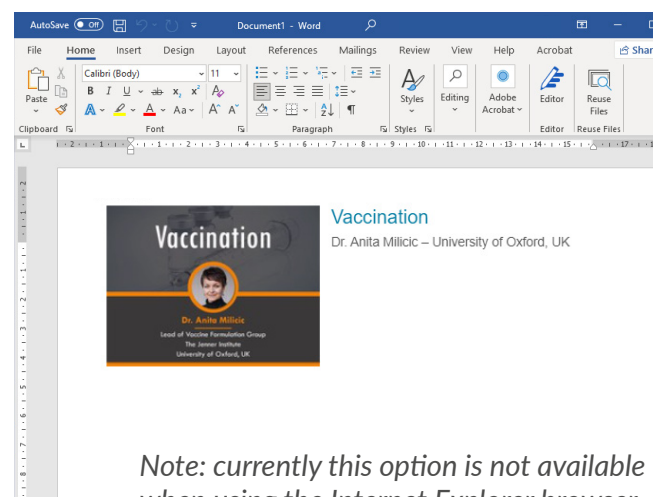

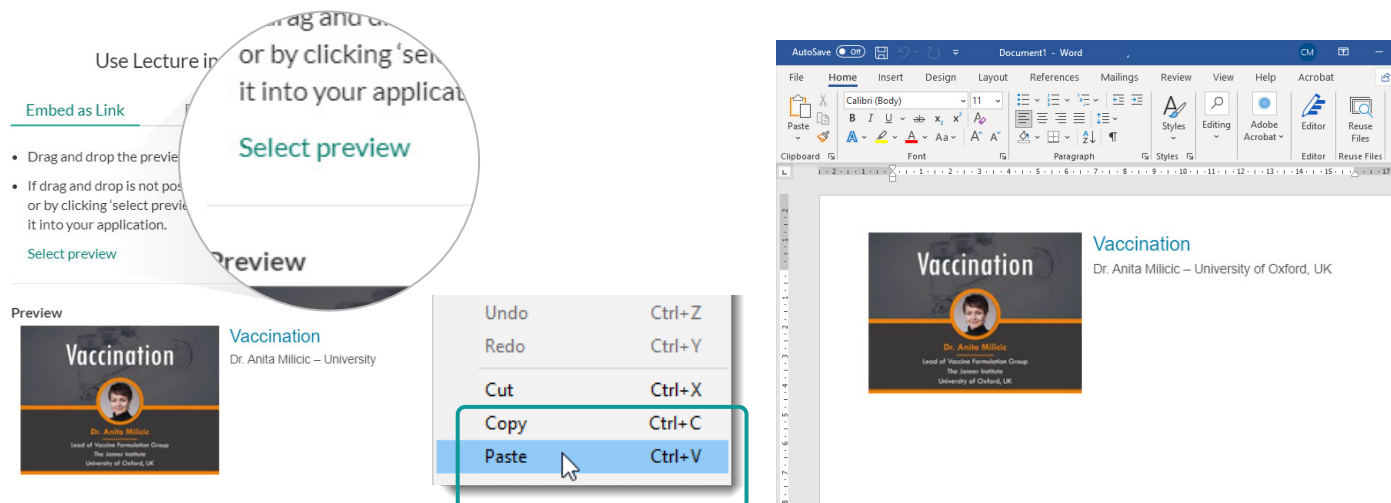

Note: currently this option is not available when using the Internet Explorer browser.

B. Copy and Paste: another way to embed a lecture as a link is to copy the thumbnail from the preview and paste it into your application of choice.

1. Manually select the preview or click the 'select preview' button on the embed page.
2. Press Ctrl+C to copy the preview to your clipboard.
3. Open your application of choice and click the place where you wish to embed the lecture.
4. Press Ctrl+V to paste (embed) the lecture



ADVANCED OPTIONS

There are several advanced options when embedding the lecture as a link:

- 1 **Easy Authentication:** When enabled, viewers will be automatically recognized as member of the institution. *Note: to use this option you need to be logged to a personal account.*
- 2 **Thumbnail Size:** Select thumbnail size or select 'none' to have only text.
- 3 **Lecture Information:** Select which information to include or untick all boxes to have only a thumbnail.
- 4 **Define a segment of the lecture:**

This can be done in two ways:

- A Enter start and end times to create a defined time segment.
- B Enter start and end slides to create a segment defined by the inclusion of slides.

The segment will be created automatically based on the inserted instructions. The preview will still show a thumbnail of the cover slide.

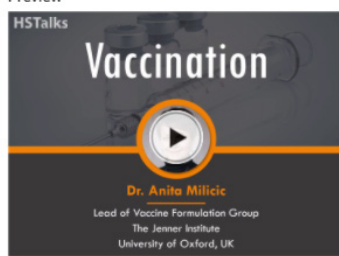

(4:3 aspect ratio will be kept automatically), although it is recommended to keep the default size (480x360).

3 Autoplay: It is possible to set the video to be played automatically. Certain browsers/devices will disable this option.

A Enter start and end times to create a defined time segment.

B Enter start and end slides to create a segment defined by the inclusion of slides.
